Tunis donated \$621,000.00 which exceeded its original commitment of \$400,000.00.

HOSPITAL DADDY PROGRAM

Several years ago we make a commitment to donate \$100,000.00 to the capital campaign through the Circus Daddy program. This year the new Daddy Program has raised \$27,000.00 towards our overall obligation. To date we have donated approximately \$50,000.00. Over the next three years we have an obligation to donate the remaining \$50,000.00 to the capital campaign through

the new Hospital Daddy Program. The Hospital Daddy Program will be operated by the Capital Shrine Club in 2017 and Noble Wayne Keech will be the program coordinator. All donations are tax deductible.

HOSPITAL DONATIONS



On December 15, Divan representatives made Tunis final donation of \$60,000.00 to Shriners Hospital for Children Canada for 2016. This brought our total donation for 2016 to just over &100,000.00 which was our objective for this year.
